## Combine VCE/VCAL with a Vocational Education & Training in Schools (VETiS) program

A VETiS (Vocational Education & Training in Schools) program enables you to widen your horizons and on successful completion, gain a nationally recognised Certificate in addition to your VCE or VCAL Certificate.

VETiS combines regular school subjects with vocational subjects - usually undertaken in years 11 & 12. A range of programs are designed to allow students to acquire industry relevant skills whilst still attending school.

VETiS contributes towards completion of the VCE/VCAL Certificate and may contribute towards an ATAR for application to higher education programs. Most programs are at Certificate II or III level and 2 years in duration. Upon completion students are provided with a nationally recognised certificate.
