

A 10 week/term-long, non-accredited program that provides students with an employment-ready portfolio and practical knowledge and insight into:

- What to expect in a workplace
- Your identification
- Apply for Tax File Number and USI
- Bank accounts and superannuation
- Budgeting and saving
- Your work choices
- Get interview-ready.

This program is fully facilitated and engages local content specialists/experts to share their knowledge.

The program contains 8 'units' and 2-3 micro-qualifications (charged Fee For Service, payable to the delivering RTO) and/or tasters.

The content can be fluid and flexible, according to the students' needs and queries.

**Age:** Years 9-12 students

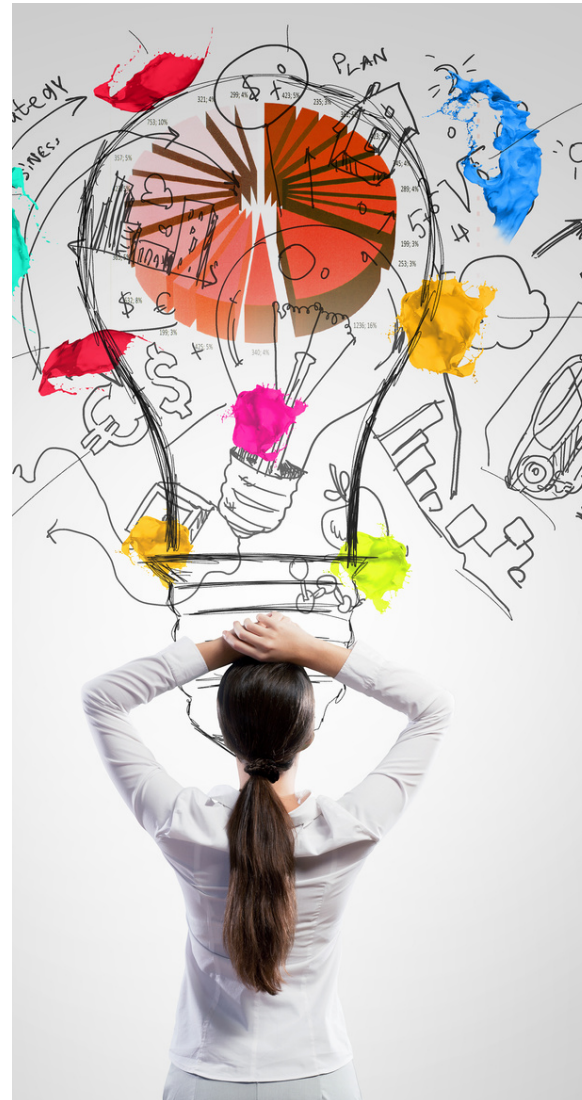
**Duration:** 1 full day per week\*
