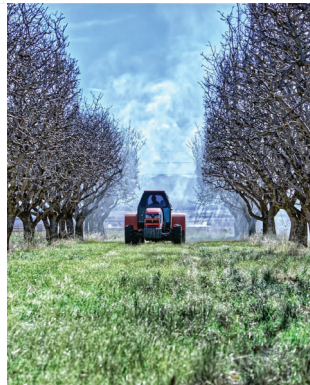




# Little Hampton Farm
